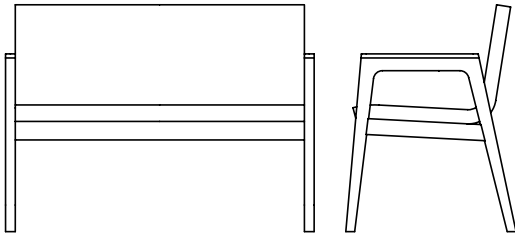

Textile: Varies per specification

Foam: High resilience polyurethane foam adhered with water-based adhesives

Frame: Solid hardwood with mortise and tenon joinery

Seat shell: Laminated and formed Gum and Poplar plywood

Wood: Catalyzed Lacquer over Ash or Walnut, Stain
